UPON COMPLETION OF CERTIFICATE III IN EARLY CHILDHOOD EDUCATION AND CARE, YOU WILL BE DEEMED TO BE QUALIFIED AS AN EARLY CHILDHOOD EDUCATOR WITH COMPETENCE AND KNOWLEDGE IN ALL ASPECTS OF CHILDHOOD DEVELOPMENT –AESTHETIC, CREATIVE, AND PHYSICAL. YOU WILL HAVE TRAINING IN FIRST AID, SAFETY CONCERNS, AND HEALTH. YOU WILL BE ADEPT AT PLANNING FOR YOUNG CHILDREN AND CHILDREN WITH SPECIAL NEEDS.

Completion of this course is the minimum requirement to work in the early childhood education sector. You will develop skills in:

- effective interaction and communication with children
- appropriate care for babies, toddlers and children
- nutrition
- first aid, health and safety
- working legally and ethically
